ALPINE CITY IN PARTNERSHIP WITH ACE DISPOSAL

“Alpine City Recycles” is a new city-wide recycling program utilizing a roll-out container for the collection of mixed recyclable materials at curbside. The City has teamed up with Ace Disposal to provide this new recycling service that will help save landfill space and reduce disposal cost at our local landfill and contribute to saving our natural resources by reusing aluminum, paper, plastic, and other recyclable materials. More types and greater quantities of recyclable items will be recycled conveniently, safely, and cost-effectively.

HOW IT WORKS

- ◆ The new curbside recycling service begins in November 1, 2005
- ◆ Each subscriber will receive a gray, 95-gallon roll-out recycling container along with a collection schedule calendar and list of recycling guidelines.
- ◆ Recyclables are picked up **bi-weekly (every other week), on the same day as your regular garbage collection.**
- ◆ Place the container in the street with the wheels against the curb or within 2 feet of the blacktop, and the front of the container facing the street, by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day.
- ◆ The container must also be placed 4 feet apart from other containers and 8 feet from mailboxes, poles, fences, trees, or parked vehicles for easy access.
- ◆ The container must be used for only acceptable recyclable materials that include certain paper, cardboard, plastic, and metal items.
- ◆ Recyclables can be commingled or mixed together in the one container.
- ◆ The container must remain in your property and properly cared for.
- ◆ Subscribers will be responsible for any loss or damage to the recycling container resulting from negligence or abuse, except for normal wear and tear.
